- Maintain safety and cleanliness of Club and RYC grounds at all times
- Complete assigned chore when RYC morning program ends
- Provide First Aid where necessary
- Promote RYC and discipline(s) at all levels
- Assist with RYC Opening and Closing Days
- Attend and participate in Closing Banquet
- Attendance and participation at Jr. Board events is strongly encouraged
- Plan, prepare, and deliver daily crafts and activities for students in the RYC morning program
- Purchase any supplies required and work within a pre-arranged budget
- Adhere to schedule by ensuring lessons begin and end promptly
- Set up all necessary equipment and supplies for classes
- Clean up all equipment and supplies following craft or activity
- Promptly notify Club Manager and Craft Advisor of any equipment problems or supply shortages
- Any reasonable duties assigned by the Commodore(s) or Vice Commodore(s)
