

LEAD ACCESS BOOM INSTRUCTOR

Reporting to the Club Manager, the Access Boom Instructor is responsible for developing and teaching the RYC accessible sailing curriculum to the Sail Canada standards.

Minimum Qualifications

- Standard First Aid and CPR
- Successful Police Background Check (Vulnerable Sector Screening) *18 years or older
- Pleasure Craft Operator Card
- Sail Canada Boat Safety Course certification

Preferred Qualifications

- National Lifeguard Service certification (Recommended)
- Sail Canada Community Instructor Training Clinic certification
- Sail Canada CANSail 1 & 2 certification

Responsibilities

Specific responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Ensure the safety of RYC Members and guests at all times
- Maintain safety and cleanliness of Club and RYC grounds at all times
- Assist other instructors and programs on and off water as needed depending on weather conditions or special program
- Complete assigned chore when program ends
- Provide First Aid where necessary
- Promote RYC and discipline(s) at all levels
- Assist with both RYC Dock In and Dock Out Days
- Attend and participate in Closing Banquet
- Attendance and participation at a minimum of 2 Jr. Board events
- Collaborate with fellow Access Boom Instructor(s) to plan and deliver safe lessons
- Collaborate with community partners (ex. Chatham-Kent Recreation Special Populations) to develop programming appropriate for youth and adults with disabilities
- Adhere to schedule by ensuring lessons begin and end promptly
- Notify Club Manager of any schedule changes
- Set up all necessary equipment for classes with other Access Boom Instructor(s)
- Able to handle physical demands of transporting and lifting equipment
- Promptly notify Club Manager and Access Boom Advisor of any equipment problems
- Any reasonable duties assigned by the Commodore(s) or Vice Commodore(s)
